Please Note:

Applications will be accepted only from students who reside in, or are attending schools in the United States. CVD opportunities are best suited for US citizens and permanent residents; however, international students can participate if space is available.

You must be a Material Advantage member to attend the Material Advantage CVD. A maximum of 5 students from any one university will be considered for a travel grant and will be eligible to attend the CVD event(s).

The Material Advantage Student Program offers a limited number of travel grants to student registrants to help offset costs to Congressional Visits Day. The amount of travel grant funds will be determined once applications are received. All grants will be sent after the event upon verification that the student was in attendance. Faculty advisors are not eligible for travel assistance.

Registrations will be processed on an individual first come, first served basis based upon the criteria noted above. Accepted registrants will receive a confirmation email. A waiting list may be started for those we cannot immediately accommodate.
