

Frequently Asked Questions:

What students qualify to become Material Advantage members?

A student in good standing at a post-secondary, degree-granting school who is pursuing an undergraduate, graduate, or doctoral degree in materials science, engineering or any related field (metallurgy, composites, coatings, polymers, biomaterials, ceramics and glass, foundry, etc.) may become a member of Material Advantage.

Do students recruited prior to 1 February 2020 count toward prizes in this membership drive?

No, only students who are recruited (and join Material Advantage) from 1 February through 29 February 2020 will be counted.

Do students who were members in 2019 count if I recruit them to renew their membership?

No – current members do not count as “recruited” if they renew their membership.

May I recruit former Material Advantage members (those who were not a member in 2019, but had belonged prior)?

Yes, if the student was not a member in 2019 they are eligible to be counted as someone that you recruit if they join in February 2020.

How will the prize money be paid out if I win?

Prizes will be awarded as a PayPal account transfer (you must have/open a PayPal account to receive the funds), or check.
